Sailing Instructions

Jurisdiction: The races will be sailed under the management of GPYC. The organizing authority is not responsible for any damages and injuries either ashore or on the water that may result from participation in this regatta.

Rules:

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in **The Racing Rules of Sailing**. U.S. Coast Guard approved life jackets shall be aboard each boat and worn by competitors as conditions warrant or as directed by the race committee.

Entries:

Competitors may enter by delivery a completed entry form and paying the regatta fee to GPYC.

US Sailing members \$ 30.00

Non members \$ 35.00

Notices to competitors

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on west side deck of GPYC deck.

Schedule & Class Flags

Registration: 8:00 -9:15

Skippers meeting will be held at 9:30AM, June 6, 2009 @ GYPC

The warning signal for the first race will be at 10:00AM.

Subsequent races will be held as soon as possible after the end of the previous race.

Lunch break will be held on course in order to maximize # of races

No Race shall start after 3:00PM

Timing: Five minute starts will be used

Racing Area

Green Pond, w/exception of shoal area marked by government buoys.

Course & Marks

The course & marks will be announced at the skippers meeting by the race committee

Time limit

The time limit for each race will be 2hrs. for the first boat to finish

Protests

The 720 rule will be in effect. Any Protesting yacht must follow IYRU rule # 68. All protests must be delivered to GPYC in writing within 1 hr. after the conclusion of the last race. Hearings will be held as soon as possible after racing.

Scoring

Low Point System.

1 Race constitutes a series

There will be one throw-out used to determine overall standings. If three or less races are sailed there will be no throw-outs. Ties will be broken in favor of the yacht that has more 1st, 2nd, 3rd etc than the others. If this does not break the tie, then it will be broken in favor of the yacht that has beaten the others in the last race in which all tied yachts started. If this does not produce a winner, the tie will be broken by the flip of a coin.

DNF & DNS will each receive one point more than the number of registrants. DSQ will receive two points more than regatta registrants.

Prizes:

Award will be presented to the top three skippers and crews.

Recalls:

if at the starting signal any part of a yacht's hull, crew, or equipment is on the course side of the starting line or its extensions, the race committee shall attempt to hail the number of the yacht. It is the responsibility of each yacht to start correctly, and failure of a yacht to hear her hail shall not exonerate her from fulfilling her obligation. In the event of a general recall, a new five minute sequence will be started. The one minute rule shall be in effect for the new sequence.

Green Pond Club Series: For GP sailors, all races will be applied to either Saturday or Sunday series as appropriate for the 2009 season standings.
