**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1 RULES**

**1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2021 – 2024 Racing Rules of Sailing, the attached waiver and release of liability, and the attached official entry form.

**1.2** Racing Rules of Sailing Part 4 preamble and RRS 40 will be changed as follows: When flag Y is displayed ashore, all competitors and crew shall wear personal buoyancy at all times while afloat except for brief periods (two 2 minutes or less) while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment.

**4 VENUE**

South Shrewsbury River

**5 THE COURSE**

The courses shall be Olympic courses, Triangles or Windward Leewards at the discretion of the race Committee. Olympics are a Triangle followed by a windward leeward windward. The Course board



will display an O for Olympic, a T for Triangle and W for Windward Leeward. For Triangles and Windward Leewards there will be a number displayed that will designate the number of *Windward Legs*. All Races will finish to windward.

## **6 SCORING**

The number of scheduled races is three (3) of which one (1) must be completed to constitute the regatta. Should wind, weather, or other conditions make it impossible or impractical to complete all three (3) races within the publicized time, the event will be terminated and the results based upon the completed number of races. There will be no dropped races for scoring purposes.

## **7 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS**

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

## **8 REQUIRED SAFETY EQUIPMENT**

**8.1** US Competitors shall carry a U.S. Coast Guard (USCG) approved personal floatation device

(PFD). Competitors from outside the U.S. shall carry a PFD approved by their nations' certification authority to the extent permitted by international treaty.

## **9. AWARDS**

**MASTERS Perpetual Trophy** - 1st Overall (must be age 45 of older)

Finishes first through third will receive trophies for skipper and crew (everyone eligible)

**14. Mask Policy:**

Masks ARE NOT required while working on a boat in the yard if maintaining 6 ft. distance from others, sitting at a table while eating or drinking, or while on the docks and while sailing.

Masks ARE required while walking inside the club house (including restrooms) and while walking on the deck and are preferred while sitting at tables if not eating or drinking.

Due to state regulations the club kitchen is off limits.
