

Sailing Instructions
Penguin / Comet Harbor Frostbite Regatta
Saturday, November 9
Gibson Island Boathouse

1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2. Entries

Competitors may enter by emailing their Class, sail number and their name to tprice@gibsonisland.com by Friday Nov 8. Entry fee is a voluntary \$5.00 and/ or a contribution of food or drink for after racing. **Please let us know you and your crew's names so we can inform the Gatehouse, to get you on the Island !**

3. Schedule and Class Flags

A competitors' meeting will be held at 1000 at the Boathouse. The warning signal for the first race will be at 1100 . Subsequent races will be held as soon as practicable after the end of the previous race. Starts will be a 3 minute sequence with sounds only. Comets will start first.

4. Racing Area

The racing area will be in Gibson Island harbor or further out in Eagle Cove if mooring area is crowded.

5. Courses and Marks

The courses will WL courses and the number of legs will be displayed on the Signal Boat course board. The courses will be discussed further at the Competitors meeting.

6. Protests

Protests shall be delivered to the boathouse 15 minutes after the race committee finish boat docks. Hearings will be held as soon as practicable after racing each day in the Boathouse.

7. Scoring

5 races are scheduled. All scores will count. One race constitutes a series.

Ramp and hoist launching available at the GI Boatworks for Comets.
Penguins can be hand launched at the Boathouse. To get to the Boatworks , get on the Island and turn right everywhere you can.
